was a Palestinian Arab village in the Safad Subdistrict. It was depopulated (غرابة: Ghuraba (Arabic) during the 1948 War on May 28, 1948, by the Palmach's First Battalion of Operation Yiftach. It was .located 22 km northeast of Safad

By the 1945 statistics the population was 220 Muslims, with a total of 2,933 dunams of land, according to an official land and population survey, Arabs used 2,928 dunams for plantations and .irrigable land
